Requirements for Application

- The applicant must be a resident of Darnestown, Maryland.
- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior accepted into a post 12th grade accredited educational program. Examples of programs include a four-year college or university, community college, military academy, or career and technical education/certification.
- Cumulative GPA must be at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent. The applicant must submit a copy of their high school transcript (unofficial acceptable).
- Applicants shall apply on their own behalf.
- The application form, as provided by the Darnestown Civic Association, shall be received by May 15, 2020.
